2. The scholarship will cover conference registration fees and the benefits associated with a full-paid conference attendance, and do not cover hotel or travel.

3. Scholarships will be awarded with the following criteria:

A. Current IRSF Partners are eligible for scholarship (2010 Partners)

B. Financial need must be established by a written description of circumstances of need.

C. Only one (1) scholarship will be given per family or household

D. Scholarships are available only once per family
