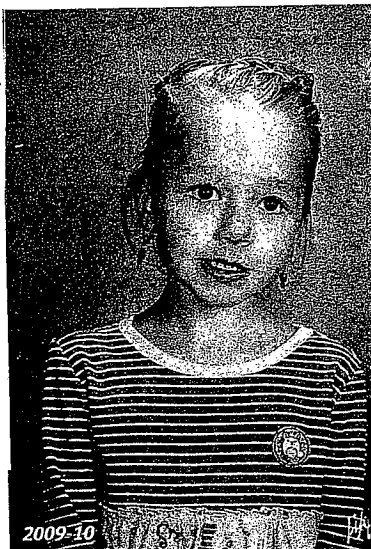

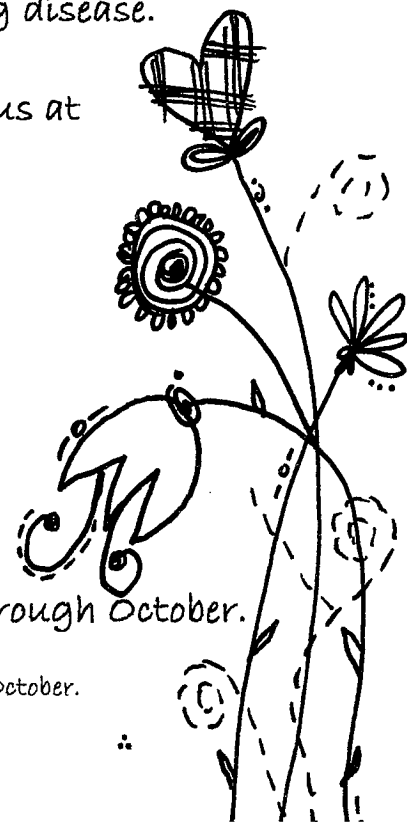

This is in response to the amendment to your organization's Articles of Incorporation filed with the state on June 27, 2007. We have updated our records to reflect the name change from Rett Syndrome Research Foundation to International Rett Syndrome Foundation.



Our records also indicate you are not a private foundation within the meaning of section 509(a) of the Code because you are described in section 509(a)(1) and 170(b)(1)(A)(vi).

Donors may deduct contributions to you as provided in section 170 of the Code. Bequests, legacies, devises, transfers, or gifts to you or for your use are deductible for federal estate and gift tax purposes if they meet the applicable provisions of sections 2055, 2106, and 2522 of the Code.
