



Thank you for registering for IRSF's very special 25th Annual Conference. This year's conference will be held May 22 - May 25, 2009 in Leesburg, Virginia at the Lansdowne Resort & Spa. A full conference program can be downloaded from www.rettsyndrome.org so that you can map your session attendance plan. Though last minute changes may be made to the schedule, you should review the program in advance so you will be sure to attend the lectures and panels most important to you.

Please note that registration fees do not include travel and hotel accommodations; these arrangements must be made separately.

REGISTRATION

Full conference registration fees include:

- All registration and conference materials
- Access to all sessions
- Friday dinner, welcome orientation, Crackerbarrels and evening entertainment
- Saturday breakfast, lunch, dinner, plus evening coffee and dessert Tribute Reception and auction
- Sunday breakfast and lunch

Single day conference registration fees include:

- Registration and conference materials
- All-session access for that day
- Breakfast and lunch for that day

TRIBUTE RECEPTION

IRSF will host a coffee, dessert, and cash bar Tribute Reception and Silent Auction on the evening of Saturday, May 23rd at the Lansdowne Resort. Attendance is open to all registered attendees. Our girls and women with Rett syndrome are welcome at no charge, and all other non-conference registered guests are welcome for \$15 per person. Dress to impress, but formal attire is not expected. Entertainment and dancing will follow the Tribute and Awards ceremony.

DRESS

We encourage you to dress comfortably for the day sessions, and wear something a little nicer for the Saturday Tribute Reception. The Friday evening jazz concert will be outside on the lawn area so bring layers. Large conference rooms can also run cool. The weather in Virginia is generally moderate during the month of May. Don't forget comfortable shoes for getting around during free time. Lansdowne has pools so don't forget your suit!

SPECIAL THOUGHTS

On a tender note, we must remind you that the conference sessions are for registered attendees only; and no children under 12 will be permitted at all in the sessions. This weekend is a fast-paced event intended to further-educate all attendees, provide you with an opportunity to interact with other members of the RTT community and provide some respite time away from the daily challenges of parenting. However, we also want you to feel welcome to bring your family members. If you choose to do so, please arrange childcare in advance so you will be free to attend sessions and network with other attendees. Many couples trade off these responsibilities throughout the weekend.



HOTEL

The IRSF 25th Annual Conference will be held at the Lansdowne Resort & Spa, 44050 Woodridge Parkway, in Leesburg, Virginia 20176. We have negotiated an incredible room rate of \$134 single/\$150 double (per night) for all conference registrants, subject to availability. There is no fee for parking. You will find a link to resort reservations off of our website, or you may contact the resort directly at 1-877-509-8400. The Lansdowne Resort & Spa is a unique location that offers many special amenities including Championship golf, Aquatic Complex, health club and world class spa. There are additional fees for some of these activities. We hope you can come a little early, or stay a few extra days, to rest and relax. The Lansdowne is offering a special rate of \$155 per night plus \$15 resort fee immediately before and after our conference to registered attendees only, subject to availability. MEALS

The meals that are included with your conference registration fee will be served at the *Riverside Hearth* restaurant, adjacent to the General Session area. LOCATION

Lansdowne Resort's scenic location in Virginia's Wine Country is conveniently located less than an hour from the Nation's Capital.

TRANSPORTATION

The resort is 20 minutes from the Capital Beltway and just 15 minutes from Washington Dulles International Airport (IAD).

- A taxi is approximately \$25 USD each way from Dulles Intl. and significantly more from Reagan National (RCA) or Baltimore/Washington Airport (BWI), plus gratuity.
- Lansdowne Resort offers a shuttle between the Resort and Dulles International Airport. The shuttle departs the resort every half hour (on the half hour) from 6:30 a.m. to 11:00 p.m. The price is \$25 per person each way, advance reservations are required. Upon arrival at airport, exit the Baggage Claim at Door #4 and wait for the shuttle at Hotel/Motel Shuttle area, curbside 2H. For reservations less than 48 hours prior to arrival—and to confirm or change an existing reservation—please call 800-541-4801 and select the Transportation option.

DRIVING DIRECTIONS

From Washington Dulles International Airport

- Leave the terminal on the airport road
- Take Exit **9B** onto Rt. 28/Sully Road North
- Go 4 miles and exit onto Rt. 7 West toward Leesburg
- Travel 3.5 miles (after 4 Lights) on Rt. 7 West
- Exit right onto Lansdowne Boulevard
- Proceed through the traffic light
- Make a right onto Woodridge Pwky.
- Make your first left into the resort

From Capital Beltway (Rt. 495) - Option 1

- Take Dulles Toll Road/Rt. 267 West
- Proceed through main toll plaza for ~11 miles
- Take Exit 9B onto Rt. 28/Sully Road North
- Go 4 miles and exit onto Rt. 7 West toward Leesburg
- Travel 3.5 miles (after 4 Lights) on Rt. 7 West
- Exit right onto Lansdowne Boulevard
- Proceed through the traffic light
- Make a right onto Woodridge Pwky.
- Make your first left into the resort

From Capital Beltway (Rt. 495) - Option 2

- Take Dulles Toll Road/Rt. 267 West
- Proceed through main toll plaza
- Follow to Belmont Ridge Road/Exit #4
- Take Belmont Ridge Road North, to the right
- Travel 3 miles and turn right onto Route 7/Harry Byrd Highway
- Stay in the Right Lane and exit to Lansdowne Boulevard
- Take first right after the traffic light
- Take first left to Resort entrance

From Richmond, VA area

- Take I-95 North toward Washington, D.C.
- From I-95, get onto the Capital Beltway (I-495 North) heading toward Tysons Corner & Dulles Airport
- From I-495 West, take the left exit #45 onto the Dulles Toll Road/Route 267 West
- Proceed through main toll plaza for ~11 miles
- Take Exit 9B onto Rt. 28/Sully Road North
- Go 4 miles and exit onto Rt. 7 West toward Leesburg
- Travel 3.5 miles (after 4 Lights) on Rt. 7 West
- Exit right onto Lansdowne Boulevard
- Proceed through the traffic light
- Make a right onto Woodridge Pwky.
- Make your first left into the resort

From Harrisburg, PA area

- Take Pennsylvania Turnpike West to Exit 17/Highway 15
- Take Rt. 15 South toward Gettysburg
- Follow Rt. 15 South to Leesburg, Virginia
- Take exit to Route 7 East/Tysons Corner
- Follow Route 7 East through 5 stoplights

- Exit on Right to Lansdowne Boulevard
- Proceed through the traffic light
- Make a right onto Woodridge Pwky.
- Make your first left into the resort

From Pittsburgh, PA area

- Take the Pennsylvania Turnpike to I-70 East to Frederick, Maryland
- Take Rt. 15 South toward Leesburg, Virginia
- Take first exit to Route 7 East/Tysons Corner
- Follow Route 7 East through 4 stoplights
- Exit on Right to Lansdowne Boulevard
- Take first right after traffic light
- Take first left to Resort entrance

From Philadelphia, PA area - Option 1

- Take Pennsylvania Turnpike West to Exit 17/Highway 15
- Take Rt. 15 South toward Gettysburg
- Follow Rt. 15 South to Leesburg, Virginia
- Take first exit to Route 7 East/Tysons Corner
- Follow Route 7 East through 4 stoplights
- Exit Right on Lansdowne Boulevard
- Take first right after traffic light
- Take first left to Resort entrance

From Philadelphia, PA area - Option 2

- Take I-95 South to the Capital Beltway/Rt. 495 West toward College Park/Silver Spring Continue on Capital Beltway/Rt. 495 following signs for Virginia
- Take Dulles Toll Road/Rt. 267 West exit
- Proceed through main toll plaza for ~11 miles
- Take Exit 9B onto Rt. 28/Sully Road North
- Go 4 miles and exit onto Rt. 7 West toward Leesburg
- Travel 3.5 miles (after 4 Lights) on Rt. 7 West
- Exit right onto Lansdowne Boulevard
- Proceed through the traffic light
- Make a right onto Woodridge Pwky
- Make your first left into the resort

From North Carolina area - Option 1

- Take I-81 North to Winchester, Virginia
- Take Route 7 Exit and proceed East on Route 7 toward Leesburg
- Take the Tysons Corner/Rt. 7 East exit
- Follow Route 7 East through 5 stoplights
- Exit Right on Lansdowne Boulevard
- Proceed through the traffic light
- Make a right onto Woodridge Pwky.
- Make your first left into the resort

From North Carolina area - Option 2

- Take I-95 North toward Washington, D.C.
- Get onto Capital Beltway/Rt.-495 North heading toward Tysons Corner/Rockville (not toward Alexandria)

- Take the left exit onto the Dulles Toll Road/Rt. 267 West
- Proceed through main toll plaza for ~11 miles
- Take Exit 9B onto Rt. 28/Sully Road North
- Go 4 miles and exit onto Rt. 7 West toward Leesburg
- Travel 3.5 miles (after 4 Lights) on Rt. 7 West
- Exit right onto Lansdowne Boulevard
- Proceed through the traffic light
- Make a right onto Woodridge Pwky.
- Make your first left into the resort
